

6 x 6 Envelope Album

1– 12 x 12 Sheet of Cardstock for cover

4–8 Standard Size Envelopes

1– 12 x 12 Sheet of Coordinating Cardstock or B&T Paper for inside cover (Cut 5 1/2 x 5 1/2)

Cardstock cut into 4 1/4 x 5 1/2 for inserts in envelopes

12” Paper Trimmer and Scoring Blade

Adhesive

Scissors

Ribbon

1. Book Cover– Cut a 12 x 12 sheet of colored cardstock into two– 6 inch strips and score each strip at 5 1/4 inches and 6 inches. Overlap the 6 inch side of one with the 5 1/2 inch side of the other and adhere them together. The 3/4 inch gap in the overlap is equal to the side width of the spine and make the book close more square. When you are finished you should have a 6 x 6 center section, a 6 inch square flap and a 5 1/4 x 6 inch flap. Embellish the front cover to match your theme or color scheme. Use a ribbon to hold the book closed.
2. Envelopes: You will be folding the flap of the envelopes backward and adhering it to the back of the envelopes. I used 5 for the pictured project but you can fit up to 8. Then adhere the envelopes to each other where they meet in the middle along the glue line. Use a strong adhesive to attach them. Embellish the top envelope to match your theme or color scheme. Adhere the last envelope to the center section of the book. Use a small amount of adhesive on the bottom of the envelopes to stick them together so the accordion envelopes do not fall out of the book when the book is open.
3. Pull Out Pages- Cut your pages 4 1/4 x 5 1/2 out of coordinating cardstock. Decorate as desired. Use ribbon and embellishments to add excitement to them. Add photos and journaling.
4. Decorate the rest of the book with coordinating papers, cardstock and My Stickease.
5. Give to a very special person!
