

Altered Clip Boards

Materials Needed:

Clip Boards- Small or Large

Papers of Choice

Stamps or My Stickease (for accents)

Photos- optional

Ribbons

Mod Podge (Available at craft stores)

Paint Brush

1. You may wish to paint your clip board with acrylic paint before starting your project. I skip this step and leave mine brown.
2. Tear paper to paste on clip board.
3. Apply a liberal amount of Mod Podge on clip board. Put paper over it. Smooth out wrinkles. Continue this process until the clip board is covered.
4. I apply the Mod Podge on top of the paper, after it is mounted, to seal the paper and prevent it from peeling.
5. Attach any photos, stamped images or My Stickease to the top of the board. Seal it with Mod Podge.
6. Tie a variety of ribbons to the metal piece on your clip board.
7. You can attach a Pentel pen to the board if you wish. I just tie the pen to the clip-board using ribbon.
