

Coaster Box

Recipe:

- 5 cardboard coasters. (you can get these at your favorite restaurant)
- x7071B Best Friends Level 2 Paper Packet
- D1186 Rustic Flowers- March Stamp Of the Month
- Z295 Spring Harmony Collection- Bigger Brads
- Z812 Hollyhock Designer Ribbon
- Z2160 Twilight Stamp Pad
- z2128 Hollyhock Stamp Pad

Directions:

1. Cover both sides of coasters with desired papers. For my bottom/front layer, I used twilight cardstock and random stamped it with the flower image and twilight ink. Then I layered striped papers on the bottom/front. For the inside, I used a coordinating striped paper.
2. Punch 5 holes on both sides on 4 coasters. (these are the sides of the boxes).
3. Line up the sides and tie knots using the designer ribbon.
4. Once you get the sides finished, glue the bottom of the box using a strong adhesive.
5. Let box dry.
6. I stamped the solid flower with Hollyhock ink once on hollyhock paper and once on Colonial White Paper. I cut out both images and used a pink brad to attach them together. Then I glued them on the front of the box.
7. Take our gusset bag and fill with desired treats.
8. Make a tag for the bag.
9. Give to someone special!
